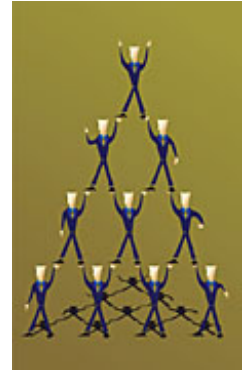




Podcast: What Three Wharton Students Learned about Leadership at the U.S. Naval Academy
